

I PROArte PROSOL COMPETITION

1. PARTICIPANTS

All plastic artists, who must be resident in Spain, and must be 30 years old or younger in 2020 may participate in the 1st PROArte Competition.

2. MODALITY. SUBJECT. MEASURES

Mode: Painting.

Themes and sizes: Free.

3. PRESENTATION

- 3.1. Each author may submit only one work.
- 3.2. The works submitted must not have participated in any competition and may not be signed until the PROArte award jury has given its verdict.

4. REGISTRATIONS

Registrations will be made exclusively online through the e-mail proarte@prosol.coffee indicating the personal data and attaching an image of the work being presented to the competition, as well as a photocopy of the author's DNI or NIE.

The registration period will remain open from November 2nd until November 30th 2020 at 23:59 hours (Spanish mainland time).

By formalising their registration, participants, in accordance with current regulations, give their consent to the processing of their personal data, which is necessary both to take part in the competition and for any other related procedures. They also give their consent for the checks and accreditations to be carried out ex oficio, without the person having to present any documentation of express authorisation.

5. DEADLINE FOR PRESENTATION OF SELECTED WORKS

Of the works presented through the platform, the jury will select those that will form part of the competition and will inform the authors so that they can physically deliver the work to the PROSOL headquarters (Avda. Tren Expreso 34200. Venta de Baños. Palencia).





The works will be delivered personally by a representative or transport agency, duly packed and with postage paid, respecting the same deadlines.

When depositing the work, the corresponding receipt will be given, which must be provided later for its collection. If the person who collects the piece is not the owner, the receipt must be accompanied by the corresponding authorisation and a photocopy of the DNI or NIE of the person authorising the collection.

The back of the work will bear the title.

6. PRIZES

The I PROArte Award establishes a single prize consisting of a grant of 3,000 euros.

7. JURY

PROSOL will determine the members of the jury, which will be chaired by the artist from Palencia, Gonzalo Páramo Pino. It will be made up of three people of recognised prestige linked to the world of art.

8. OWNERSHIP OF THE WORKS

The winning work of the PROArte award will become the property of PROSOL. Its author expressly authorises its reproduction by any means and expressly renounces his or her copyright.

9. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

PROSOL may, if necessary, make any changes it deems appropriate to the health situation resulting from Covid-19 for the proper functioning of the competition. It shall also resolve any questions that may arise regarding the interpretation of the rules.

The insurance of the work presented will be borne by the participants and under no circumstances will it be the responsibility of PROSOL.

The result of the jury's decision, which will be made known in the third week of December 2020, will be notified directly to the winner and will be announced on PROSOL's social networks.
